Person-centered care: What role can play occupational therapy?

Client - centred occupational therapy is a partnership between the client and the therapist which empowers the client to engage in functional performance to fulfil his /her occupational roles in a variety of environments. The client participates actively in negotiating goals which are given priority and are at the centre of assessment, intervention and evaluation. Throughout the process the therapist listens to and respects the client's values, adapts the interventions to meet the client's needs and enables the client to make informed decisions. This approach of intervention enables encourage and improve self-esteem, focusing on the skills and strengths of the patient.

n this session we will explain the symbology of "grigri", the name that is given to amulets in Western Africa and their effects in the urban processes of contemporary African cities. We will also know the origin of the project and its connection to the programme "Objetos Comunes", released by Medialab in 2016, which asks about the actual challenges of material culture in the digital era.
